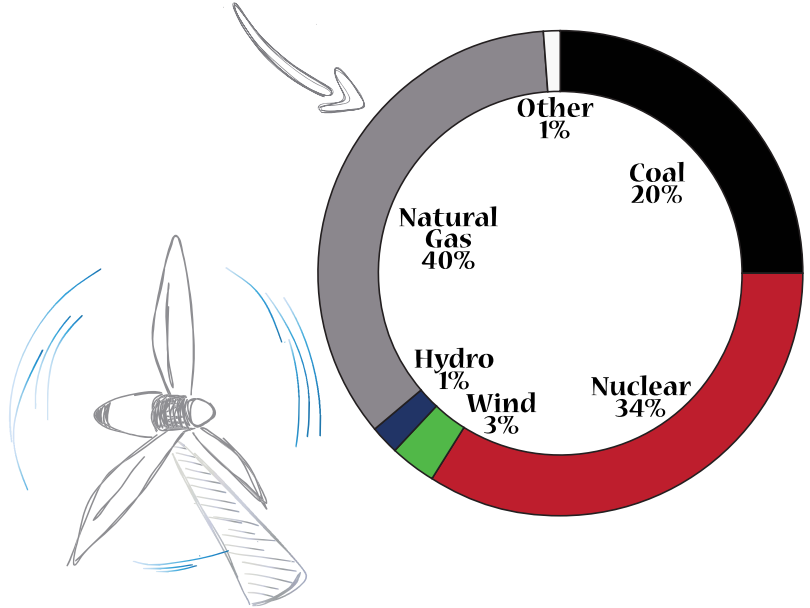

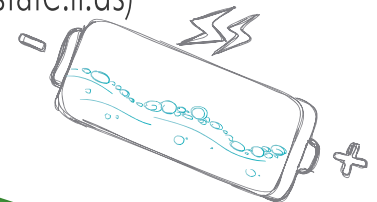
Air Emissions
